
CORE PURPOSE

RESPONSIBILITIES *the Gas Engineer will...*

- ✓ Carry out gas servicing, repair works and rectify any gas faults to domestic gas central heating installations and remedial works.
- ✓ Liaise with both clients and customers when arranging and carrying out works.
- ✓ Undertake fault diagnosis and reports for domestic properties.
- ✓ Manage own workload in conjunction with the Gas Supervisor requests.
- ✓ Undertake all works in accordance with relevant health and safety legislation and safe methods of works.
- ✓ Understand the obligation to have a duty of care toward its clients and operate accordingly.
- ✓ Create accurate risk assessments and method statements.
- ✓ Be responsible for a company vehicle ensuring that it is maintained, kept tidy and cleaned as required in line with company policy. Ensure that vehicle stock levels are maintained to the appropriate level and that accurate records are kept.
- ✓ Keep personal relevant gas qualifications up to date as per the role requirements.
- ✓ Carrying out minor works in a range of non-trade related tasks which may include; Patch plastering, painting and filling to damaged areas, tiling or minor joinery repairs to floorboards or panelling.
- ✓ Be available to cover emergency out of hours rota when required.
- ✓ Actively engage, demonstrate and contribute to the organisation's values (ASPIRE).

- ✓ Up to date ACS Gas Safe qualifications with a minimum of CCN1, CENWAT & HTR1
- ✓ Be competent in carrying out minor works in a range of non-trade related tasks.
- ✓ Good knowledge of Health and Safety and the ability to identify risks.
- ✓ Good knowledge of IT systems, applications and equipment and keep up to date with best practices and new initiatives.
- ✓ Experience of working with power tools.
- ✓ The technical ability and knowledge to deliver works to meet Gas Safe standards to ensure compliance is achieved.
- ✓ The ability to work to deadlines and provide a high standard of customer care.
- ✓ The ability to work from ladders, scaffolding, MEWP's and in confined spaces or other difficult work environments.
- ✓ Ideally having experience of working in domestic properties in relation to a social housing environment where the requirement to maintain domestic gas installations is essential.
